GOAL:

The **Green Construction Academy** will prepare its participants for a range of entry level career opportunities and life-long job skills in green construction trades.

Three Programs offered!

Green Construction: Learn basic construction skills for energy-efficient building in new construction and weatherization and retrofitting existing buildings.

Deconstruction: Learn about recycling, reusing, and reducing waste when remodeling, or removing existing buildings. Acquire the Knowledge necessary to recycle and sell salvage materials from deconstructed projects.

Weatherization Technician: Learn how to perform energy audits and to diagnose wasted and inefficient energy systems in existing buildings. Use audit information to determine energy and environmental savings in existing and new construction.

Grant information:

This is a Federal grant funded program for green technology training, targeting the following people:

- At-risk youth
- Economically disadvantaged youth
- Dislocated workers
- Individuals in need of updated training
- Under-employed workers

Frequently Asked Questions

What will I learn about green construction? The courses teach the basic construction skills of tool safety, tool operation, environmentally friendly construction methods and green products.

How long is the program? There are two types of programs. Our Summer Academy runs for 6-8 weeks during the full work day. During school year, there are classes offered that coincide with semester-long school programs.

Will I get to work on actual construction projects? Yes! The program has community partners where you will get to observe and work on local green projects.

Will I get paid to attend the programs? Yes! You may be eligible for an on-the-job wage during the Summer Academy if you meet the requirements for our target population.

Will I get high school credit for the school classes? Yes! The school-year classes are considered for High School elective credit and are considered unpaid training.
