OSHA 40 & 24-HOUR HAZWOPER Course

This course is intended to assist in satisfying the training requirements of the Hazardous Waste Regulations Part 1910.120. The standard was specifically developed to protect workers that may be exposed to hazardous waste at uncontrolled hazardous waste sites and at EPA licensed waste treatment storage and disposal facilities as well as workers responding to emergencies involving hazardous materials such as spills and leaks.

Intended Audience:

- Workers in cleanup operations at uncontrolled hazardous waste sites.
- Workers at EPA-licensed waste TSD facilities.
- Workers responding to emergencies involving hazardous materials.
- Lapsed HAZWOPER certificate (i.e. failure to attend required 8 hr. annual refresher)
